LONG TERM CAMPING (MUST READ)
General Camping Rules and Regulations and Cancellation/Refund Policy

- PARK RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY AND ALL APPLICATIONS FOR LONG TERM CAMPING FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING BUSINESS OPERATIONS REASONS, IF DEEMED NECESSARY BY MANAGEMENT.
- PARK RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISMISS OR REMOVE ANY LONG TERM CAMPER FROM THE CAMPGROUND WITHOUT NOTICE IF ANY OF THE BELOW RULES OR REGULATIONS ARE NOT FOLLOWED AND/OR IF MANAGEMENT DEEMS IT NECESSARY FOR ANY REASON.
- After 30 days, camper must reapply for an extension. There is no guarantee application will be approved.
- Check out time is 12 PM and check in time is 2 PM.
- Max 6 people per RV Site and must be immediate family members. **NOTE:** Site RV-1 only site with sewer.
- Max 2 vehicles per campsite. And may be asked to park in parking lot if deemed necessary for space concerns.
- Quiet hours are 11 PM – 7 AM.
- Please pick up trash & put in trash cans. Please keep fire rings and grills clean.
- Registered campers and registered guests only permitted in park after sunset and before dawn.
- Visitors to campsites permitted from 7 AM – 11 PM. (Fee may be assessed)
- **Renter will not destroy, deface, or vandalize any property in camping areas such as picnic tables, fire rings, grills, trees, etc. If doing so will result in immediate dismissal from campground.**
- **Renter is responsible for any damages to park property.**
- No alcoholic beverages or controlled substances.

- Parks Staff reserves the right to eject individuals and/or whole party/renter who displays misconduct, destruction of property and/or use of alcoholic beverages or drugs and/or involved or suspected of controlled substance possession, dispersal, selling, or any other illegal activity.
- Random background checks are possible as well as background checks if reports of suspected illegal activity is reported and park management deems necessary.
- If law enforcement is contacted for any reason to your campsite and/or on any individual associated with your rental, immediate dismissal from the campground will be enforced.
- Area is patrolled by KY Dept. of Fish and Wildlife law enforcement, local police & sheriff, and park rangers.
- Personal items outside of camper must be kept to a bare minimum. Personal items such as refrigerators, large appliances, old cars/trucks, machinery, misc parts, etc. are not permitted.
- Items such as grills, coolers, tools, storage containers, and other items are to be kept at a bare minimum and management may ask that these items be concealed.
- Outside of camper areas and campsite must be kept clean, neat, tidy, and free of trash, debris, and unsightly/rusted items. Any items deemed distracting or unpleasant will be asked to be removed from campground. If refused, dismissal from campground will be enforced.
- NO animals, livestock, birds, geese, or other type of animals are to be kept in cages outside of campsite. Some pets such as dogs, cats are permitted for a short time.
- NO fireworks or discharge of a fireman for recreational reasons.
- A full list of rules and regulations for Lake Shelby area will be given to you at check-in.
- **RV CANCELLATION / REFUND POLICY FOR LONG TERM STAYS (Over 14 days) ONLY:**
- Reservations cancelled 15 days or more from check in date, will result in a \$25.00 cancellation fee.
- Reservations cancelled 7-14 days from check in date, will result in a \$75.00 cancellation fee.
- Reservations cancelled 0-6 days from check in date, will result in forfeiture of first 7 night payments.
- NO refunds for inclement weather; no alternate facility available.

Renter has read and understands the terms of this application and agrees to abide by all rules and regulations instituted by Lake Shelby Management. And understands that you may be asked to leave if any of these regulations are not followed and/or if park management deems it necessary for business reasons or any other reason. CHECK HERE:
