What are your interests?

Athletic League Coaches - Provides instruction, coordination and leadership to a sports league team for a season. Many sports available, individuals can pick desired sport.

Concession Stand Attendant - Operate a concession stand during base-ball/soccer season. Attendant will prep and handle basic food, track cash transactions & maintain a clean workspace.

Campground Host - Provides assistance and information to campers, registers campers & provides some custodial and maintenance services.

C3 Program Van Driver - Transports children from elementary schools to the Family Activity Center after school releases during the school year.

C3 Food Service Attendant - Assists with packing, delivering and issuing lunches in partnership with the Shelby County Public School system to the C3 summer camp participants. Will require a food handling training and attendant will drive a park van.

Events/Programs Assistant - Provides assistance in chosen event/ program. Assistant may direct traffic, handle admissions, operate vendor booth, etc.

General Maintenance - Provides services to the park grounds and facilities, including custodial services.

Golf Course Volunteer - Provides services as a golf course attendant or as in golf maintenance. Monitors and controls plays on golf course, cart attendants, driving range attendants, general maintenance and pro shop work or assists the green keepers in maintaining the greens, fairways and golf course in general. Assists in minor repairs and cleaning of golf carts, equipment, etc.

Groundskeeper - Provides park grounds with improvements in planting, painting, repairs and some custodial services.

Horticulturist - Cares for plantings and assists with maintaining flower beds, gardens and care for trees and other plant species.

Photographer - Takes photographs or videos of park facilities, special events and recreational activities.

Trails Steward - Provides routine maintenance & helps to curb vandalism.

Volunteer Benefits

Benefits are available at all parks during the term of service of a volunteer.

Free passes to the Family Activity Center (gymnasium, walking track, indoor/outdoor pool, dry sauna, weight room)

Free passes to aerobic classes at the Family Activity Center (Zumba, water aerobics, Strength, Piloxing, Yoga, etc)

Membership to the Family Activity Center

Campground hosts receive one free campsite in the park campground during the duration of service.
