C3 Camp Quick Reference



All campers must be registered online at shelbycountyparks.com



Campers will be picked up by our camp staff at individual school and brought back to the FAC. Schools include Clear Creek, Heritage, MCMS, Painted Stone, Southside and Wright Elementary.



\$50 per week per camper. All past due balances must be paid in full for registration to be accepted. **NO REFUNDS.** Payments must be made online or by phone. 502-633-5059 | shelbycountyparks.com



Students may be picked up anytime until 6:00pm. \$1 per minute late fee will be charged after 6:00pm



Campers will have their temperature checked with a non-contact digital forehead thermometer before entering the van.



Please txt @c3schoolky to 81010 to get updates and to alert us of your arrival so we can send your camper to you for pick up.



C3 camps follow all child care requirements for Covid-19. Please inform your camper of the importance of safe boundaries and appropriate behavior during this time.

Camp Health Guidelines

- At drop off each morning a counselor will ask the parent/guardian if the child has had a cough, fever or shortness of breath in the last 72 hours. If the answer is yes, the camper will NOT be allowed to attend camp until they have been symptom free for 72 hours.
- If a camper develops a fever of 100 degrees or higher or consistent cough during the camp day a parent will be notified immediately to come pick the camper up. The camper may return after being symptom free for 72 hours.
- Parents are responsible to let the Camp Director know immediately if their child has symptoms or has been diagnosed with a Communicable Disease.
- Parent/Guardian will be notified immediately if a camper becomes ill or sustains an injury of a serious nature.
- Please do not bring your child to camp if they feel ill, or have had a fever, coughing, vomiting or diarrhea.
- A child must be fever and cough free for 72 hours and 24 hours for vomiting and diarrhea.
- C3 camps will utilize a maximum group size of ten children per group.
- Children will remain in the same group of ten children all day without being combined with another group.
- The same staff members will work with the same children each day in order to reduce additional exposure.
- Childcare programs will not hold field trips.
- Those approved to be in a childcare program are limited to:
 - Facility staff
 - Persons with legal authority to enter (first responders, Department for Community Based Services, Division of Regulated Childcare, etc.).
 - Necessary utility workers or Professionals providing medical/therapeutic services for children with special needs
 - Children enrolled in the facility
 - Parents or legal guardians of children enrolled in the program
- C3 camps must eliminate lost and found bins
- Campers need to bring their own personal water bottle. Staff will make sure that campers will be able to refill water bottles throughout the day



Campers will be picked up from their individual schools by a C3 staff member. Clear Creek, Heritage, MCMS, Painted Stone, and Wright are included in the schools for pickup. Southside student will be brought to the park by bus. C3 camps follows all Covid-19 guidelines for child care and transportation.

All drivers will be wearing a mask at pick up. Drivers will keep a list of all campers that are enrolled for each school. Temperatures will be checked by camp staff as campers enter the van. Mask must be worn on the bus for 1st grade and above, unless there is a medical condition preventing the camper from wearing one. All vans will be sanitized after each use.



Once campers arrive they will stay with their school in groups of no more than 10 with the same staff member everyday. Campers will be provided a snack, time to work on homework and physical activity and games. Campers will have access to playgrounds gyms and rec fields as well as other areas around the park.

Parents need to download the Remind app or txt @c3schoolky to 81010 to receive txt updates and to inform the camp of your arrival to pick up your camper. Camp staff will escort your camper to your care to avoid extra people and exposure to the building. You must be on the campers pickup list and show your ID to pick up the camper. Campers can be picked anytime until 6:00 pm.



Payment Policy and Registration

Due to COVID-19 restrictions set forth by Governor Andy Beshear, our camp capacity will be capped at 10 campers per school. Payments must be made by Monday at 10:00am of the current week in order to confirm your campers spot each week. The fee for C3 After School Camp is \$50 per week per camper. Failure to make payment on time may result in the camper losing their spot or not being picked up from school. We expect with the low capacity that camp will sell out. There will be no refunds UNLESS agreed upon with the camp director.

Covid restrictions require us to be contactless in our registration and payment process. All campers must be registered online at shelbycountyparks.com. Please follow the instructions on the website to fill out you're application and to make payments. To make a payment you can call the park office at 502-633-5059 or through the website at shelbycountyparks.com.
