C3 Camp Quick Reference



All campers must be registered online at shelbycountyparks.com



All campers will have access to the Park Wi-Fi to complete all the necessary requirements for NTL. Camp staff will not be able to assist in school instruction.



\$100 per week per camper. All past due balances must be paid in full for registration to be accepted.



Campers will be asked to wear a mask in certain times when moving around the building and at drop off.



Campers will be signed in by a single staff member outside the guardians car. Campers will have their temperature checked with a non-contact digital forehead thermometer.



Hours of operation are 8:30am - 4:30pm.



Campers need to bring a lunch with them each day. Snack will be provided.



Please txt @c3nti to 81010 to get updates and to alert us of your arrival so we can send your camper to you for pick up.



C3 camps follow all KY Healthy at Work requirements for Covid-19. Please inform your camper of the importance of safe boundaries and appropriate behavior during this time.

Camp Health Guidelines

- At drop off each morning a counselor will ask the parent/guardian if the child has had a cough, fever or shortness of breath in the last 72 hours. If the answer is yes, the camper will NOT be allowed to attend camp until they have been symptom free for 72 hours.
- If a camper develops a fever of 100 degrees or higher or consistent cough during the camp day a parent will be notified immediately to come pick the camper up. The camper may return after being symptom free for 72 hours.
- Parents are responsible to let the Camp Director know immediately if their child has symptoms or has been diagnosed with a Communicable Disease.
- Parent/Guardian will be notified immediately if a camper becomes ill or sustains an injury of a serious nature.
- Please do not bring your child to camp if they feel ill, or have had a fever, coughing, vomiting or diarrhea.
- A child must be fever and cough free for 72 hours and 24 hours for vomiting and diarrhea.
- C3 camps will utilize a maximum group size of ten children per group.
- Children will remain in the same group of ten children all day without being combined with another group.
- The same staff members will work with the same children each day in order to reduce additional exposure.
- Campers need to have a mask and will be asked to wear them in certain times while moving through the building.
- Childcare programs will not hold field trips.
- Those approved to be in a childcare program are limited to:
 - Facility staff
 - Children enrolled in the facility
 - Parents or legal guardians of children enrolled in the program
- C3 camps must eliminate lost and found bins
- Campers need to bring their own personal water bottle. Staff will make sure that campers will be able to refill water bottles throughout the day.

ATTENTION

All campers will have access to Wi-Fi and designated areas to work. C3 Camps will not be providing educational instruction for NTL, but camp staff can assist with basic needs. All school supplies need to be brought with your camper each day. We will not be able to provide supplies for projects or other school needs. We will provide various times throughout the day for camper to take a break from school and participate in other activities. All campers must pack a lunch.
